

Hearing God – Lesson 3

John 10:27 Amplified Bible (AMP)

²⁷ The sheep that are My own hear My voice *and* listen to Me; I know them, and they follow Me.

John 10:25-32 New Living Translation (NLT)

²⁵ Jesus replied, “I have already told you, and you don’t believe me. The proof is the work I do in my Father’s name. ²⁶ But you don’t believe me because you are not my sheep. ²⁷ My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. ²⁸ I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one can snatch them away from me, ²⁹ for my Father has given them to me, and he is more powerful than anyone else.^[a] No one can snatch them from the Father’s hand. ³⁰ The Father and I are one.”

When we know God's voice it builds confidence in what we feel He has told us to do.

We know His voice by:

- The Spirit – The Spirit lives on the inside of us and helps us interpret and understand what God desires for us to know
- We develop a knowing of His voice by our relationship with Him
- The more we study His word the closer we will be to Him

When we speak about hearing God it is not with a natural ear but that which is spiritual. Therefore it is not really the ear but the heart that hears.

How does this happen? – Through a genuine relationship with the Father.

What trains our heart to hear God?

- His Word
- Prayer
- Living Holy before God
